Waqf property data to be digitized soon

aking cue from PM Narendra Modi's advice that the records of Waqf property in the country should be updated. Union minority welfare minister Nazma Heptullah said on Thursday that her department is pursuing it hard, putting emphasis on the registration and digitization of Waqf property.

Heptullah was in Patna to discuss with the state government the implementation of Union government's programmes and schemes meant for the welfare and upliftment of all minority sections, including Muslims who constitute the largest segment of population from among the minority groups, as well as matters related to Wagf property with the Muslim clerics.
